(B) **WHEREAS** it is also important that all members of the Perak Bar are aware of issues regarding human rights and matters of diversity.

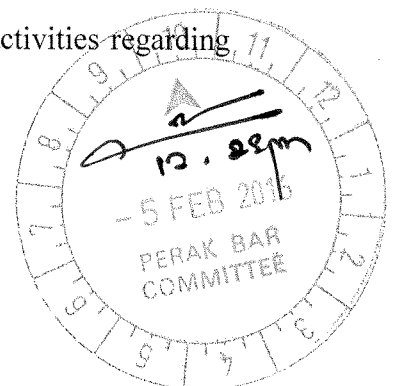

**WE** hereby resolve:

**THAT** the Perak Bar adopt and implement the following recommendations as soon as possible.

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

- a) **THAT** the Perak Bar should organize on an annual quarterly basis training, events, talks, courses, lectures, seminars and/or other related activities regarding issues of human rights.



- b) **THAT** the Perak Bar should organize on a half yearly basis training events, talks, courses, lectures, seminars and/or other related activities regarding issues of diversity.
- c) **THAT** the Perak Bar should organize on an annual quarterly basis events, talks, courses, lectures, seminars and/or other related activities regarding current professional practices.

(c) **WHEREAS** it is an important requirement and duty of the Perak Bar to provide and maintain such facilities for the benefit of all members of the Perak Bar.

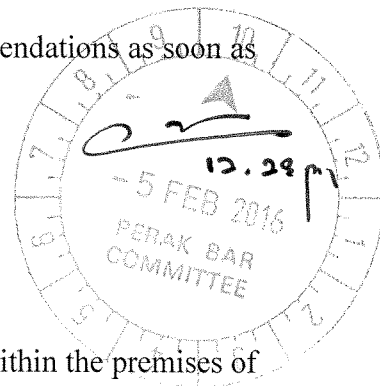
**WE** hereby resolve:

**RECOMMENDATIONS**



b) **THAT** the Perak Bar acquire the relevant computer facilities in order to enable all members of the Perak Bar to access the online legal data basis such as the current law journal and/or lexis.



- c) **THAT** the Perak Bar implements a suitable timetable and/or diary to enable an equal and fair opportunity for all members of the Perak Bar who wish to access such facilities at the Perak Bar premises during normal working hours.

**Proposed resolution regarding the provision of training events  
for pupils-in-Chambers**

Motion proposed by Steven Hoe, dated 5 February 2016 for consideration and adoption by the Perak Bar Annual General Meeting to be held on 18 February 2016.

(A) **WHEREAS** it is a legal requirement that any person wishing to be admitted as an advocate and solicitor to the Malaysian Bar, should have satisfactorily served in Malaysia the prescribed period of pupillage for a qualified person, pursuant to section 14 of the Legal Profession Act 1976.

(B) **WHEREAS** it is important that Chambering students / pupils-in-chambers are given a fair opportunity to participate in all training events organised by the Perak Bar and/or the Malaysian Bar and/or third parties accredited by the Perak Bar and/or the Malaysian Bar, irrespective of their financial means.

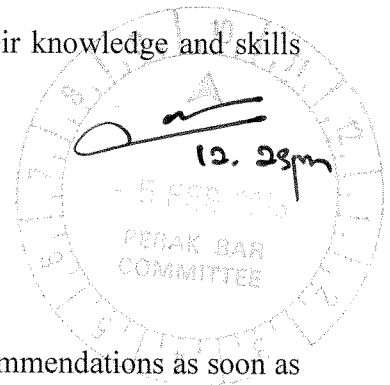
(c) **WHEREAS** it is also important that Chambering students/pupils-in-chambers keep abreast with recent developments in law and enhance their knowledge and skills with current practices.

**WE** hereby resolve:

**THAT** the Perak Bar adopt and implement the following recommendations as soon as possible.

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

a) **THAT** all chambering students / pupil-in-chambers should be exempted from paying the cost involved in participating on all training events, courses, lectures,



talks, seminars and other related activities organized by the Perak Bar and/or the Malaysian Bar and/or third parties accredited by the Perak Bar and/or the Malaysian Bar.

- b) **THAT** this exemption shall only be available for chambering students and/or pupils-in-chambers ordinarily resident in the state of Perak and are undertaking their chambering in the state of Perak.
- c) **THAT** the cost involved in exempting these chambering students and/or pupil-in-chambers be borne by the Perak Bar.
