### **Secretariat**

Our employees are Ms. Kariam Kaur and Ms. Nur Aziela Binti Zamri. It is worthy to note that our employees continue to show commitment and effort in carrying out their duties. To remunerate them, we gave a salary increment and yearly bonus. Apart from the full time staff, we engage the services of a cleaner, accounts clerk and dispatch clerk on contractual basis.

As for the Secretariat building, there were several repairs and maintenance that had to be done. Amongst others were repairs to the upper floor ceiling from rain water seepage and leakage from the water tank. Apart from same, there were the usual utility bills and maintenance costs which are shown in the accounts.

### **Finance**

The financial status of the Perak Bar is reflected in the balance sheet, income and expenditure accounts and cash flow statements. We have a surplus of RM 29,866.00 for the year ending 31.12.2015.

Throughout the year, we organized several events namely the Inter State Bar Games, Annual Dinner, Advocacy Training Course and talks under the Continuing Professional Development Scheme.

We have been able to maintain a healthy reserve of funds to cater for our current and future expenses. The monies that have been deposited in fixed deposits at various banks amounts to RM 431,190.31 with 'cash at bank' amounting to RM 77, 864.16.

It is worthy of mention that our Chairman constantly requested the committee members, as far as possible, to seek and obtain sponsorship for any proposed events. At the very least, we were greatly encouraged to seek contributions from members to offset the expenses of any particular event. It is hoped that 2016 will be a better year for all of us.

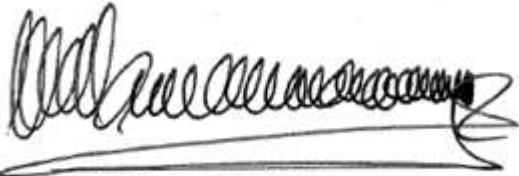
