**MINUTES OF THE 33rd ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE PERAK BAR HELD ON
FRIDAY, 22nd FEBRUARY 2019 AT KINTA RIVER FRONT HOTEL, IPOH,
PERAK DARUL RIDZUAN.**

1. The meeting was called to order at 3.25 p.m. by the Chairman, Mr. Surindar Singh A/L Chain Singh. The Chairman welcomed and expressed his gratitude to the Members for attending the 33rd Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Perak Bar.
2. The Chairman invited the Members to refer to page 3 of the Perak Bar Annual Report 2018/2019 for the Agenda of the 33rd AGM.

Item No. 1 – To Confirm and Adopt the Minutes of the Perak Bar Annual General Meeting held on 09.02.2018

3. Mr. Kenny Lai Choe Ken referred to page 7 of the Perak Bar Annual Report 2018/2019 and requested to amend “Malaysia Singapore Bar Game” to “Malaysia Singapore Bar Games”.
4. Encik Danial Rahman bin Yang Razali proposed the Minutes to be passed as amended and seconded by Mr. Robert S Gnanarajan.

Item No. 2 – To Consider Matters Arising from the above Previous Minutes of AGM

5. Mr. S.V. Namasoo raised the issue of lack of interpreters in court previously raised by him at paragraph 47, page 8 of the Perak Bar Annual Report 2018/2019.
6. Mr. Surindar Singh A/L Chain Singh, the Chairman, informed the floor that the complaint was brought up to the Chief Justice. The same issue will be brought up in Bar Council Annual General Meeting on 16.03.2019. The Perak Bar will update the members on the same.
7. Mr. S.V. Namasoo also raised the issue of the “KPI” at paragraph 45 page 7 to 9 of the Perak Bar Annual Report 2018/2019. He would like to know whether KPI is still in implementation because in his experience, he was once forced to withdraw his matter on the ground of KPI where the respective Judge said the Court is still bound by the 9-month time frame to resolve a case.
8. The Chairman informed the floor that the Perak Bar is unsure whether “KPI” is still in implementation because there is no official practice direction issued by the Chief Justice to address the same to-date. The Chief Justice however has made verbal statements that the “KPI” system has been relaxed.
9. Mr. S.V. Namasoo stressed that the Bar ought to seriously raise this issue before the Chief Justice again to resolve the “KPI” issues faced by the members. The Chairman has taken note of the same and informed the floor that the Bar will follow up with the matter and keep the members informed of any updates.

Item No. 3 – To Consider and Adopt the Annual Report 2018/2019

10. The Annual Report was proposed by Mr. S.V. Namasoo and seconded by Encik Danial Rahman bin Yang Razali.

Item No. 4 – To Consider and Pass the Accounts for the period 1.1.2018 to 31.12.2018

11. The Balance Sheet, Income, Expenditure Accounts, Cash Flow Statements and Report of the Internal Auditors at page 16 to 22 were perused.
12. Mr. S.V. Namasoo raised some questions with regard to the sponsorship/ subsidy given to Nine (9) members to attend the International Malaysia Law Conference 2018. He wanted to know how the selection of members were conducted and what are the benefits derived from such sponsorship / subsidy.
13. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal informed the floor there was a reduction in the registration fees for the said International Malaysia Law Conference which was a 4-day program. In view of the low participation from Perak Bar, we decided to sponsor Nine (9) members, all of which are active members of the Bar. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal further informed the floor that only Two (2) Committee Members attended the said event and the rest attendees were active young lawyers of Perak Bar.
14. The account was proposed to be passed by Encik Danial Rahman bin Yang Razali and this was seconded by Mr. S.Dharmanathan A/L Suppiah Saminathan.

Item No. 5 – To Elect the Chairman of the Perak Bar Committee for the year 2019 / 2020

15. Before the nominations and election began, the Chairman declared that the Chair of the Perak Bar was vacant and called for nomination from the floor. The Chairman also thanked all the previous committee for the hard work. The Chairman then invited Mr. S.V. Namasoo to chair the meeting accordingly.
16. Mr. S.V. Namasoo announced that the nomination for the Chairman was opened. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed Mr. Surindar Singh A/L Chain Singh as the Chairman for the year 2019/2020 and this was seconded by Mr. Mathialagan s/o Matguramuthu.
17. Mr. Pushotamdas A/L Nathermal proposed the nominations for the Chairman be closed and this was seconded by Mr. Santhiran A/L Veloo.
18. Mr. S.V. Namasoo announced that Mr. Surindar Singh A/L Chain Singh as the Chairman of the Perak Bar Committee for the year 2019/2020.

Item No. 6 – To Elect Ten Members of the Perak Bar Committee for the year 2019/2020

19. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed Mr. Varpal Singh A/L Menender Singh and this was seconded by Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal.
20. Mr. Mathialagan s/o Matguramuthu proposed Dato' Shamsuriah Binti Sulaiman and this was seconded by Mr. Varpal Singh A/L Menender Singh.
21. Mr. Pushotamdas A/L Nathermal proposed Mr. Kenny Lai Choe Ken and this was seconded by Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy.
22. Mr. Varpal Singh A/L Menender Singh proposed Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy and this was seconded by Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal.
23. Mr. T.Ellangovan a/l Thambiraju proposed Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal and this was seconded by Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy.
24. Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal proposed Puan Nurul Jannah Binti Khairul Anwar and this was seconded by Mr. Varpal Singh A/L Menender Singh.
25. Madam Fong Poh Kuan proposed Madam Tan Yin Fong and this was seconded by Madam Sylvia Liew Sek Yuen.
26. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed Mr. Balakrishna Balaravi Pillai and this was seconded by Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal.
27. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed Encik Hazril Azam Bin Abdul Hamid and this was seconded by Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal.
28. Dato' Shamsuriah Binti Sulaiman proposed Encik Mohamad Hafiz Bin Jalaludin and this was seconded by Puan Nurul Jannah Binti Khairul Anwar.
29. Mr. Kenny Lai Choe Ken proposed Ms. Mary Ann Alphonse and this was seconded by Mr. Pierre Chuah Lee Yan.
30. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed Mr. S.V. Namasoo and this was seconded by Mr. Surindar Singh A/L Chain Singh.
31. However, Mr. Babu Raja A/L Raja Gopal and Mr. S.V. Namasoo declined the nominations.
32. Mr. Mathialagan s/o Matguramuthu proposed that the nomination be closed. Hence, the Ten (10) members as above are elected as Members of the Perak Bar Committee for the year 2019/2020.

Item No. 7 – To Elect the Representative of Perak Bar to the Bar Council for the year 2019/2020

33. Mr. Balakrishna Balaravi Pillai proposed Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal and this was seconded by Mr. T.Ellangovan a/l Thambiraju.
34. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed that the nomination be closed and this was seconded by Mr. Kenny Lai Choe Ken.
35. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal therefore was elected as the Perak Bar Representative to the Bar Council for the year 2019/2020.

Item No. 8 – To Appoint Two (2) Honorary Auditors

36. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal proposed Mr. Pushotamdas A/L Nathermal and this was seconded by Mr. Kenny Lai Choe Ken.
37. Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy proposed Madam Lee Pooi Mun and this was seconded by Mr. Kenny Lai Choe Ken.
38. Puan Nurul Jannah Binti Khairul Anwar proposed that the nominations be closed and this was seconded by Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal.
39. Hence, Mr. Pushotamdas A/L Nathermal and Madam Lee Pooi Mun were thereby being appointed as two (2) Honorary Auditors for the term of 2019/2020.
40. Mr. S.V. Namasoo proposed a vote of thank you to the previous Committee Members.

Item No. 9 – General Matter Arising

41. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal informed the floor about the CLJ and Lexis Nexis package motion [see item 8 at page 26 of the Perak Bar Annual Report] to be ventilated in the Bar Council AGM on 16.03.2019. The Bar Council has managed to negotiate a deal with CLJ and Lexis Nexis service providers whereby members of the Malaysian Bar would be required to pay an annual subscription fee of RM180.00 per year to access both CLJ and Lexis Nexis database. Each member will be given their own individual account and password to access the database.
42. Madam Kamala Mahlini A/P P Jeganathan would like to know whether it will be made compulsory for all members to pay this sum of RM180.00. The Chairman and Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal explained to the floor that in the event the motion is passed at the upcoming Bar Council AGM, all members are required to pay the sum of RM180.00 of which will become part of our annual subscription fees payable to the Bar Council.
43. Madam Ma Foong Yin suggested that the members ought to be allowed to try out the package deal at an earlier date. The Chairman informed the floor that the package deal will be available for the members to test it out starting from 1st of June 2019 if the motion is passed at the upcoming Bar Council AGM.

44. Mr. V.Sreedaran Nair A/L A.Veloo Pillay opined that this is a good motion and ought to be passed.
45. Madam Kamala Mahlini A/P P Jeganathan opined that such package deal should not be made mandatory on all the members as smaller law firms or sole proprietor especially those not in litigation practice generally do not subscribe to such service providers.
46. Mr.Kenny Lai Choe Ken explained to the floor that this package deal is costs saving for majority of the lawyers. He further explained that such package deal in fact is designed for smaller firms (even sole proprietors) to save costs as members would only be required to pay approximately 10% of what would be the normal CLJ or Lexis Nexis subscription fees.
47. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal proposed that Perak Bar AGM reports in the future to be delivered to all the members by way of e-mail in PDF format. This motion is to save costs as the Bar has spent approximately RM7,000.00 – RM8,000.00 annually to purchase the CD and deliver the same to all the members.
48. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal further informed the floor that the annual expenses for Perak Bar AGM cost about approximately RM11,000.00; approximately RM3,000.00 of which were allocated for hotel booking and approximately RM1,500.00 were used to purchase envelopes.
49. Mr. S.V. Namasoo opined that the Bar should ensure all the members get the e-mail. Mr Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal informed the floor that the Bar has an updated e-mail list and the system does show whether the respective member has read the e-mail.
50. Mr. S.V. Namasoo would like to know if all the members possess an e-mail. Chairman explained to the floor that a written notice will be sent out to all the members by post before the AGM. Members will be duly notified of the Annual Report and the same can be collected from the Secretariat for those do not have an e-mail.
51. Mr. Pushotamdas A/L Nathermal would like to know how the Bar distinguishes between a firm's e- mail and individual's email. He also opined that senior lawyers (above 12 years in practice) ought to update their e-mail addresses with the Perak Bar because majority of them do not actively use e-mails.
52. Mr. Mathialagan s/o Matguramuthu would like to know how many members of Perak Bar possess an e-mail.
52. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal explained to the floor that the Annual Report will be sent to all the individual e-mails registered with Perak Bar. Members are encouraged to update their e-mail addresses with the Perak Bar. In our record, approximately 10% of all the members do no check or read their e-mails.
53. The Chairman urged the members to register or update their e-mails with the Perak Bar to enable them to receive any updates from the Bar in the future.

54. This motion is proposed to be passed by Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal and this was seconded by Mr. Vivekanandan AMS Periasamy.
55. Mr. Babu Raj A/L Raja Gopal informed the floor that with regard to the issue of typo errors on the seniority list at page 55 of the Perak Bar Annual Report, the respective member ought to to inform the Bar Council to correct the errors as it is not within the control of the Perak Bar.
56. Mr. Mathialagan s/o Matguramuthu would like to know why the Perak Bar has stopped using the High Court premises to conduct the AGM as was done in the past. Encik Danial Rahman bin Yang Razali explained to the floor that it became difficult to rent the court premises for the use of Perak Bar AGM due to the tension between the Bar and the Judiciary a few years ago. It was also difficult to vacate the old court on a Friday as recorded in the previous minutes of the Perak Bar AGM.
58. However, Mr.Kenny Lai Choe Ken further informed the floor that the current High Court Judge Dato' Hashim bin Hamzah is friendly towards the Bar. The Lordship has offered the High Court Room No. 5 for pupils to host their call celebration. In fact, the Perak Bar Auditorium is also available for pupils to host their call celebration with no charges.
59. Lastly, the Chairman informed the floor that another issue to be considered is whether the High Court would be able to hold all the members for AGM as there are limited seats available.
60. There being no other matters, Mr. V.Sreedaran Nair A/L A.Veloo Pillay proposed AGM to be dismissed and this was seconded by Mr. Harbhajan Singh A/L Gurdial Singh. The meeting was thereby adjourned at 4.30 p.m.

There was rumour that the Ipoh Court will be shifted to Meru. However, we clarified this directly with the Chief Registrar in December 2019 and was informed that there is no such proposal. We have now decided to renovate the perak bar building. Our main plan is to increase the sitting capacity of our auditorium and a well-equipped and spacious library. We are in the mist of securing quotations from several contractors which will cover the structural works and interior design. We are planning to start renovation works by March 2020.

I am also proud to inform members that we have revamped our web services. Our official webpage at <http://perakbar.org> has been redesigned. We are also including the online payments whereby members will be able to pay subscription and seminar fees through online banking and apps like touch n' go and boost. We also planning to launch the 'Perak Bar App' by June this year. If successful, we will create history by becoming the first State Bar to introduce the same.

FINANCE

The financial status is reflected in the balance sheet, income, expenditure accounts and cash flow statements. Despite our usual expenditures, we have been able to increase our fixed deposit amount to RM 485,968-71 and a healthy 'cash at bank' of RM 156,403-95. This is important as we do foresee increase in our expenditure as our renovation works will cost us in the region of RM300,000-00.

Besides that, let me assure that monies are well spent for the benefit of our members. The committee decided not to fully subsidise the young lawyers for all events. However, we did contribute for the attendance for seminars, sports and law conference. We have also spent on books to update our library. New text books on different areas of law has been purchased and we hope that members could utilise them. The law reports – CLJ and MLJ has been updated to current year. Certain portion of the funds are also utilised to upkeep and maintain our secretariat.

BAR REPRESENTATIVE REPORT

The 2019/2020 year has been a challenging and hectic year for the Malaysian Bar. Internally, we were busy with amendments to several legislations and the proposed e-court system. Externally, we were busy with national issues pertaining the 1MDB saga and the high-profile cases.

A. LEGAL PROFESSION BIL 20119

After much effort in drafting the Legal Profession Bill and considering the members' opinion on the same, the draft was submitted to AGC on 9/1/2019. The AGC suggested few amendments which was streamlined by August 2019. In the meantime, a meeting with Court was held on 24/10/2019, to, among others, brief the Court on the Bill. On 29/10/2019, BC received the Court's feedback. On 1/11/ 2019, a meeting was held with the AGC to discuss on the second draft. On 18 /11/2019, a meeting between BC and the 4 office bearers of the Court was held to discuss these matters. On 19/11/2019, the Court sent its updated feedback to the AGC taking into account our views on 18 /11/2019. Further to the Court's feedback and the BC meeting held on 7/12/2019, BC sent its further proposed amendments to AGC on 18/12/2019. The Bill is expected to be tabled in Dewan Rakyat during the March sitting.

The Council also proposed amendments to the Civil Law Act 1956, Law Reform (Marriage and Divorce)(Amendment) Act 2017 (LRA), Legal Profession (Personal Injury) Conditional Fee Rules 2019, Legal Profession (Non-Personal Injury) Conditional Remuneration Rules 2012 and Income Tax 1967.

B. LEXIS NEXIS

As members are well aware, the Malaysian Bar had a dispute over the subscription agreement signed with LexisNexis. On 12/9/2019, LexisNexis filed a suit against the Malaysian Bar. Malaysian Bar filed and served the Defence statement on 19/11/2019. At the same time, the BC also mandated the past Presidents, namely, Christopher Leong and Steven Thiru to start negotiations with LexisNexis with a view to resolving the matter amicably. Members can access the cause papers filed which was annexed to the **Circular No 009/2020**.

The Council dealt with numerous issues and proposals. Few are highlighted here :-

1. E-FILING / SIJIL ANNUAL APPLICATION

The latest on the e-filing system [EFS] is the application of Roaming Certificate with effect from 14/02/2020. Instant updates are posted on our official webpage and circulars are directed to members of any problems and its' solutions. Constant interactive sessions are arranged to sort the problems faced by our members.

The Council played an active role in the online sijil annual applications. As at 21-12-2019, total of 20,602 applications were received and 20,585 applications were processed.

2. CPD SCHEME

As of 13/12/2019, the Online Training Platform has 92 videos in 15 categories. It has 4,200 users, and the videos in total have accumulated 15,043 views.

For the Cycle 4 (01/07/2018 to 30/06/2020), a total of 1,214 events have been accredited. In relation to the number of events organised by BC, State Bar Committees, Legal Aid Centres, and Advocacy Training, the data is as follows:

- Bar Council: 328
- State Bar Committees: 414
- Legal Aid Centres: 40
- Advocacy Training: 30

Out of 1,214 accredited events, the CPD Department has received 1008 attendance lists, where the recorded data shows that 23,494 Members and 12,552 Pupils had attended these events.

Total of 51 CPD Camps were organised between 01/07/2018 and 13/12/2019, benefitting 686 Members and 373 Pupils.

3. YBGK

One of the issue which became controversial is regarding the delay and deductions of payment to lawyers. The YBGK Board meeting was held on 21/11/2019. YBGK HQ was instructed by the AG to give effect to the decisions made at the YBGK EXCO meeting in January 2017 in regard to deductions of payment to YBGK lawyers. I believe the Chair for Legal Aid and YBGK will address this issue in her report extensively.

Meanwhile at the first National Legal Aid & YBGK Committee (NLAC) meeting held on 11/05/2019, a subcommittee on YBGK Training was formed comprising Ravi Nekoo, Rajpal Singh and Ravi Chandran. One of the matters which is top of the chart is revising the YBGK course syllabus with assistance from the Criminal Law Committee.

4. COURTS – RULES AND PRACTISE DIRECTIONS

E- LELONG – the system will be implemented to whole peninsular Malaysia in the year 2020. We have highlighted to the Court several issues raised by the members – unable to amend the particulars as in the e-lelong system and members are forced to withdraw the auction and the 3% fee.

NUMBER OF JUDGES HEARING LEAVE AND APPEAL CASES – The judiciary proposed that only one Judge hears the leave application. The Court Liaison Committee conducted a survey via BC Circular No 238/2019 dated 5-11-2019 for purposes of getting members’ feedback on the Judiciary’s proposal. The Committee’s position that the current practice be maintained was included in the circular. Majority view of members based on the survey feedback is for the current practice to be maintained.

At the meeting of 16-11-2019, Council unanimously adopted the recommendation of the Court Liaison Committee that the current practice be maintained for both applications for leave to appeal and panels hearing civil and criminal appeals. The decision was conveyed to the Judiciary vide letter dated 26-11-2019.

E-REVIEW – Council have proposed several key amendments to the practise direction in January 2020.

5. AMLA – COMPLIANCE

On 18-11-2019, BC wrote formally to BNM to request the following:

- (i) BNM to brief Council members and the Subcommittee on AMLATFA. The briefing took place on 6 -12-2019 at the BC Secretariat.
- (ii) To ask for an extension of time for the Bar to revert with its feedback on the Exposure Draft;
- (iii) To seek the consent of BNM to allow BC to draw up a regulatory framework on AMLA-compliance for members of the Bar; and

- (iv) BNM to conduct the Training the Trainers' Programme for Council members and the Subcommittee on AMLATFA.

BC to relook the definition of "small law firm", and to propose a higher figure for the threshold for a law firm's total annual sales turnover as the current figure of RM3 million is too low. On 18 Oct 2019, the AMLATFA Subcommittee agreed that BC should propose to BNM to increase the threshold of law firm's total annual sales to RM10 million to be categorised as small firm.

BC to set up a special Committee and invite a senior partner from a few big law firms to be part of the same with a view to studying the Exposure Draft and making recommendations on how to resolve the AMLA-compliance issue.

The Subcommittee on AMLATFA is to simplify the BNM circular based on a standard form format for members' better understanding and to facilitate compliance.

6. PREPARING FOR A SELF-INSURANCE FUND SCHEME (SIF)

On 06/07/2019, Council approved the following:

- (i) PII's recommendation that the Bar migrate to SIF in 2020 on a hybrid system;
- (ii) PII Committee to negotiate with insurer/s for a viable ratio;
- (iii) The SIF scheme to be named as "Malaysian Bar Professional Indemnity Fund".

On 09/11/2019, PII Chairperson, Ragunath Kesavan and JLT met with BNM on the proposed SIF Scheme. BNM requested detailed information about the SIF Scheme as well as the "hybrid system". JLT and PII Committee are working on this.

The draft LPA Bill has introduced a new provision for SIF, ie Malaysian Bar Professional Indemnity Fund. PII Committee is awaiting the holistic amendment to the LPA to be passed in order to implement items (a) and (b).

7. LAW CARE

Proposal was made to broaden the scope of LawCare funds. This will include increasing the financial assistance, creating a special pool of mediators to assist partnership disputes and to provide support for members who are facing disciplinary proceedings. I am glad to inform that the LawCare and Welfare Committee had approved the amendments to the LawCare Rules to increase the benevolent fund from RM25,000-00 to RM50,000-00 which was approved by the Council on 07/12/2019 subject to certain alterations.

I stress again that the above are just number of issues which the Council dealt with. Our action sheet runs to almost 100 pages!!!!.

I also take this opportunity to thank the Members of Perak Bar for giving me the pleasure to serve as your Bar Council Representative. To my fellow committee members, I thank them individually for the great response and support.

PERAK BAR DEVELOPMENT REPORT

The Perak Bar presented its case to the Perak State Authorities to obtain a piece of state land measuring about 1.4 acres adjacent to the Syariah Court at Maxwell Road, Ipoh in March 2012. Further to the said application we presented our request for the state land in a document called "Perak Bar's Proposed Centre of Learning and Syariah Legal Aid" and it was handed over personally to YAB Menteri Besar of Perak on 16/11/2013.

We also brought up the land application issue with various reminders and verbal reminders to the relevant authorities but sadly we are yet to get a positive response and I regretfully believe that the said land has now been given away to some other party to use as there are now sheds erected on the said land.

I am still in constant touch with Mr. William Lye the Chairman of the Asia Pacific section of the Victorian Bar's Commercial Practice whom I recently met in Penang in January 2019, who is still keen in wanting to establish the Asia Pacific Centre of Learning for Arbitration and Mediation which is to be set up in Ipoh with their teaching support.

Unfortunately, the proposed centre of learning could not proceed with full force until we get the state to alienate the land which we have applied for as we are to create the infrastructure facilities for the Victorian Bar to operate the centre of learning. We are however considering other methods to move this forward and we may have to apply for a new piece of land instead.

I would like to record my sincere thanks and appreciation to the Chairman of the Perak Bar Mr. Surindar Singh A/L Chain Singh and the entire Perak Bar Committee Members for their support and assistance. I also wish to thank Miss Kariam Kaur and Cik Nur Aziela Bt Zamri for their usual hard work and dedication towards the Perak Bar.

LAPORAN JAWATANKUASA CONVEYANCING

Tahun 2019 menyaksikan beberapa perubahan penting di dalam sistem pendaftaran dan urusan di pejabat-pejabat tanah di seluruh Perak dan juga Lembaga Hasil Dalam Negeri (LHDN) yang secara amnya perlu dipatuhi oleh ahli-ahli Perak Bar bagi memastikan keberkesanan dan kelancaran urusan mereka.

Justeru itu, Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar telah mengadakan beberapa perbincangan dengan pihak-pihak yang terlibat bersama-sama dengan wakil ahli jawatankuasa yang lain di dalam tahun 2019 dan juga tahun 2020 sebelum perantikan ahli jawatankuasa yang baru bagi memastikan pematuhan ketetapan dan garis panduan dituruti oleh pihak-pihak yang berkenaan. Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar juga turut mengedarkan borang kritikan dan aduan kepada ahli-ahli Perak Bar bagi mengumpul maklumat dan aduan yang berkenaan untuk diketengahkan kepada pihak-pihak yang berkaitan sewaktu perbincangan.

Pihak Perak Bar telah berusaha untuk mendapatkan maklumbalas yang tepat dan sesuai dengan keperluan semasa ahli-ahli Perak Bar. Pada 17hb April, 2019, Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar telah mengadakan satu perjumpaan dengan LHDN bagi untuk membincangkan perkara-perkara seperti yang di bawah.

- i. Seminar P.U dan Cukai Keuntungan Harta Tanah;
- ii. Seminar Duty Stamp mengikut Perintah dan Pindaan Undang-Undang (termasuk prosedur untuk pemulangan semula wang (refund)); dan
- iii. Penguatkuasaan pembayaran secara atas talian (online) untuk penyeteman dan lain-lain.

Seterusnya, pada 16hb Julai, 2019, Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar sekali lagi mengadakan mesyuarat dengan LHDN bertempat di Restoran Hadramout bagi membincangkan tentang pengurusan seminar dan urusan yang melibatkan mereka dan juga ahli-ahli Perak Bar. Perjumpaan tersebut juga membincangkan tentang perintah-perintah peremitan terkini dan akan datang, e-stamping (duti setem), syarikat harta tanah (SHT), dan juga sekali lagi, kesalahan peguam-peguam dalam menyerahkan borang-borang Cukai Keuntungan Harta Tanah kepada pihak LHDN. Walaupun tarikh akhir untuk perjumpaan rasmi LHDN bersama dengan ahli-ahli Perak Bar yang lain telah ditetapkan pada 31hb Julai, 2019 pada jam 2.30 petang sehingga 5.30 petang, kedua-dua pihak masih gagal untuk mendapatkan persetujuan berkenaan dengan kos-kos yang perlu ditanggung dalam menguruskan seminar tersebut memandangkan pihak LHDN memerlukan jumlah peserta yang besar, iaitu 200 orang dan kemudahan di bangunan Perak Bar adalah amat terhad dan tidak dapat menampung jumlah tersebut.

Pada tarikh yang berbeza, iaitu pada 29hb Januari, 2020, pihak Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar dan juga jawatankuasa Perak Bar yang lain telah menghadiri satu perjumpaan dengan pegawai-pegawai daripada Pejabat Tanah dan Galian Negeri Perak bagi membincangkan isu-isu yang berkaitan dengan pendaftaran dan lain-lain. Perjumpaan

tersebut adalah perjumpaan pertama sebelum Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar dapat bertemu dengan Pengarah Pejabat Tanah dan Galian Perak, Dato' Rumaizi sendiri. Di dalam pertemuan tersebut, pihak-pihak telah membincangkan isu-isu yang antara lainnya ialah:-

- i. Pendaftaran dokumen-dokumen rasmi di pejabat tanah seluruh Perak;
- ii. Tempoh gantung dan tolak dokumen-dokumen yang telah didaftar;
- iii. Tempoh dan durasi masa untuk kutipan geran asal;
- iv. Pembukaan lebih kaunter bagi urusan pendaftaran dan tempoh waktu yang lebih panjang terutamanya pada hari Jumaat;
- v. Pelaksanaan carian tanah secara atas talian (online);
- vi. Pembayaran dan penggunaan dokumen-dokumen yang telah diakui sah;
- vii. Lain-lain urusan.

Ahli Jawatankuasa Conveyancing Perak Bar kemudiannya mencapai kata putus dengan pegawai-pegawai Pejabat Tanah dan Galian Perak untuk mengadakan satu lagi pertemuan terakhir yang rasmi bersama-sama dengan Pengarah Pejabat Tanah dan Galian Perak dan juga Pengerusi Perak Bar yang akan dihadiri oleh ahli-ahli jawatankuasa Perak Bar yang lain. Sementara itu, pihak Pejabat Tanah dan Galian telah bersetuju untuk mengeluarkan satu garis panduan yang akan merangkumi segala aspek urusan niaga yang melibatkan peguam dan pejabat tanah kepada Perak Bar untuk diserahkan dan dihebahkan kepada ahli-ahli Perak Bar.

Harapan kami, garis panduan tersebut dapat disiapkan dengan lebih awal dan lengkap bagi mengelakkan masalah-masalah yang remeh-temeh di antara kedua-dua pihak dan memastikan kelancaran urusan di pejabat mereka. Pihak LHDN juga akan seterusnya menetapkan tarikh-tarikh yang bersesuaian untuk mengadakan dan merealisasikan seminar-seminar yang diharapkan berguna kepada ahli-ahli Perak Bar secara keseluruhannya.

COURTS LIAISON SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

The basic function of the committee is to be a conduit pipe between the Bench and the Bar to ensure the smooth functioning of the judicial system in Perak. In this respect, numerous meetings were held between the Bar and the Bench, including courtesy calls with Ipoh High Court Judge and the Director of the Ipoh Lower Courts as well as the judicial officers. Also a courtesy call was held with the Taiping High Court Judge and the judicial officers. The meetings were as follows:-

i) **Mesyuarat Mengenai Isu Permasalahan Siasatan, Perundangan dan Eskot OKT**

It was held on 6.3.2019 which was attended by officers from the Court, the Chairman and Mr. S.V.Namasoo on behalf of the Perak Bar Committee, Puan Nurul Jannah as the YBGK representative of the Bar, officers from the Prisons Department, Prosecution Unit, Welfare Department and various divisions of the Police Force. The meeting was chaired by YA Datuk Hashim bin Hamzah in Bilik Gerakan, Ipoh High Court. Among the issues raised for consideration by the Perak Bar was as regards the Magistrates instruction that bail proceedings will not be conducted in the afternoon due to communication and transport problem between the police and prison officials, charges not being read out to the accused due to non availability of Vietnamese interpreters, complaints of change of urine samples being tampered with and the issue of delay in returning deposit monies and the original document of titles in auction matters. Also whether the issue of whether the Key Performance Indicator (KPI) was still in force was raised however a definite answer was not forthcoming but the Chairman informed that file management is completely at the discretion of the presiding judicial officers.

ii) **Courtesy calls**

- a) With the Ipoh High Court Judge and court officials was held on 18.3.2019 in Ipoh High Court.
- b) With the Taiping High Court Judge and court officials was held on 1.8.2019 in Taiping High Court.
- c) With the Director of the Lower courts and court officials was held on 5.8.2019 in Ipoh High Court.

In all the above meetings the usual issues brought up by the Bench was as regards the conduct of some lawyers in respect of punctuality and etiquette. It behoves on each member of the Bar to ensure that at all times in dealing with the Bench and also with fellow lawyer that proper courtesy and decorum is maintained. This duty must be honoured by lawyers who take on the task of being a master to instill in the pupil the essential qualities of being an advocate and solicitor to uphold the image of the Bar at all

times. Unfortunately, during my meeting with pupils in chambers there is generally a glaring lack of such guidance.

During the course of the year some issues were brought up by the members that required attention and action as follows:-

i) Worn out chairs in lower courts

The matter was brought up numerous occasions by the Chairman personally with the Director of the Lower Court as well as the YA Datuk Hashim bin Hamzah. Ultimately the Chairman brought up the issue to the Chief Justice who indicated that budget has been approved to repair the chairs. However we note that the old chairs in Magistrate Court (Civil 1) has not been repaired but replaced by other chairs from the court premises.

ii) Air condition

This issue of non – functioning air conditions was brought up by Fong Po Kuan in respect of Magistrate Court (traffic) and by Balakrishna in respect of Magistrate Court 2 (Criminal) and the issue has been resolved.

iii) Refund of deposit

The firm of M/s Arthur Yeong Nonee Ashirin raised the issue of unfair deduction from the deposit in a writ of seizure and sale case in Terengganu court. The Chairman had informed his counterpart in Terengganu Bar to assist as it is outside our jurisdiction and the same has been conveyed to the said firm.

There were some minor issues brought up but all have been resolved due to the close working relationship between the Bar and the Bench.

However one issue that remains unresolved is the lack of Chinese and Tamil language interpreters in Perak Courts. The matter has been brought up by the Perak Bar Committee to the Bar Council to be taken up with the Chief Justice and it is awaiting fruition.

Also as I had suggested that the Perak Bar Committee take up with the Bar Council the matter up coming up with correct terminology for addressing judicial officers as part of the effort to ensure that proper etiquette is maintained at all times.

CRIMINAL LAW SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

The post of Pengarah Pendakwaan Negeri Perak (“PPN”) from 1.8.18 till the date of this report has been helmed by Tn. Hj. Azahar Bin Mokhtar.

E-filing for all criminal matters in the Ipoh and Taiping courts had been running smoothly and we are hoping that it will be extended to more courts in Perak in the nearest future.

The moratorium put in place by the Criminal Law Subcommittee of the Bar Council for new applications for the Court Assigned Counsels has been lifted and new applications are now welcomed if a member of the Bar meets the criteria / requirement to be included in the said list which has been increased by the Bar Council in 2018. The current criteria is that the applicant needs to have been in a minimum of 5 years in practice AND must have had handled 5 Capital punishment cases prior to his or her application. (This was an increase from having been 3 years in practice and having handled 3 Capital punishment cases prior to 2018.)

It is also welcomed that the Chief Justice, Justice Tengku Maimun Tuan Mat has agreed with the proposition by the Malaysian Bar to revise the fees for the said court-led legal aid fees for assigned counsels to attract more senior lawyers to act for accused persons in criminal cases. It was stated by YAA in YAA’s speech when opening the National Colloquium on Access To Justice 2020, quote: “While access to justice is important, lawyers must also be adequately compensated for their time and resources. At present, we do not have that many senior counsels taking up legal aid work or assigned cases. So, should the revision prove possible, then it would provide better incentives for senior counsels to assist in criminal cases” unquote.

1) PERAK PENANG BAR GAMES 2019

Kejohanan yang berusia 56 tahun ini telah berlangsung pada 29 & 30 haribulan November. Pada tahun ini, Pulau Pinang telah menjadi tuan rumah setelah Perak menjadi tuan rumah pada tahun sebelumnya. Kejohanan ini merupakan pertandingan sukan yang paling tertua dalam sejarah Majlis Peguam Perak dan Pulau Pinang.

Futsal merupakan acara pembuka tirai kejohanan pada tahun ini. Majlis Peguam Perak telah membariskan ramai peguam-peguam muda dan juga pelatih dalam kamar bagi menguatkan pasukan. Perlawanan futsal telah diadakan pada jam 8.00 malam di Kinta Lane Futsal, Georgetown.

Perak yang diketuai oleh Encik Yusof bin Mohamad Salleh telah berjaya menewaskan Pulau Pinang dengan jaringan 6-4. Pada satu ketika, kedudukan terikat 4-4 namun 'super sub' Muhammad Syafin berjaya menjaringkan 2 gol pada saat-saat akhir bagi menutup peluang Pulau Pinang memenangi perlawanan ini.

Pada tahun ini, perlawanan persahabatan futsal yang melibatkan pemain-pemain veteran tidak dapat diadakan akibat kekurangan pemain.

Pada keesokan harinya, acara sukan lain berlangsung. Pada sebelah pagi di Old Frees Association, Penang telah berlangsung perlawanan tenis dan ping pong. Tenis yang diketuai oleh Kenny Lai telah tewas 2-0 begitu juga dengan Ping Pong yang diketuai oleh Khairul Anuar Musa tewas 1-4 di tangan Pulau Pinang. Ternyata gelanggang Old Frees Association tidak membawa tuah kepada Perak kali ini.

Sukan bola tampar juga berlangsung pada sebelah pagi di Universiti Sains Malaysia. Perak yang diketuai oleh Hazril Azam tiba di gelanggang dengan semangat yang berkobar-kobar untuk menewaskan Pulau Pinang yang sememangnya handal

dalam sukan ini. Perak telah memberikan satu persembahan yang menakjubkan apabila berjaya menewaskan Pulau Pinang buat tahun kedua berturut-turut kali ini dengan mata 3-2.

Bola jaring yang dilatih oleh Ruzitah binti Sabrani juga tidak kurang hebatnya apabila mudah menewaskan Pulau Pinang dengan jaringan 15 berbalas 3 dalam perlawanan yang berlangsung di Universiti Sains Malaysia.

Sukan boling telah berlangsung pada sebelah tengahari di Sunshine Square. Pasukan Perak telah menghantar pemain-pemain handalan yang diketuai oleh Radzmin untuk menghadapi Pulau Pinang. Perak telah tewas namun pemain-pemain telah memberikan tentangan yang sengit kepada lawan.

Dalam masa yang sama, sukan badminton telah berlangsung di Chinese Recreation Club, pasukan Perak yang diketuai oleh Wong Kar Keat telah memberikan tentangan yang sengit kepada Pulau Pinang namun ternyata pemain-pemain badminton Pulau Pinang berada di dalam kelas yang tersendiri. Pulau Pinang telah memenangi sukan badminton.

Pada sebelah petang, acara yang ditunggu-tunggu iaitu bola sepak telah berlangsung di Penang Free School. Perak telah berjaya menewaskan Pulau Pinang 9-0 dalam perlawanan yang dikuasai penuh oleh Perak yang diketuai oleh Noor Shafarin. Sementara itu, Syahrul Nizam telah berjaya menjaringkan 2 gol dan dinobatkan sebagai pemain terbaik perlawanan.

Pada sebelah malam telah diadakan acara penyampaian hadiah kepada pemenang-pemenang. Peguam-peguam dari kedua-dua negeri berkesempatan untuk berkenalan dan mengeratkan hubungan di antara satu sama lain. Pertandingan 'boat race' juga telah diadakan setelah selesai makan malam yang telah dimenangi oleh Perak Bar.

2) INTERSTATE BAR GAMES 2019

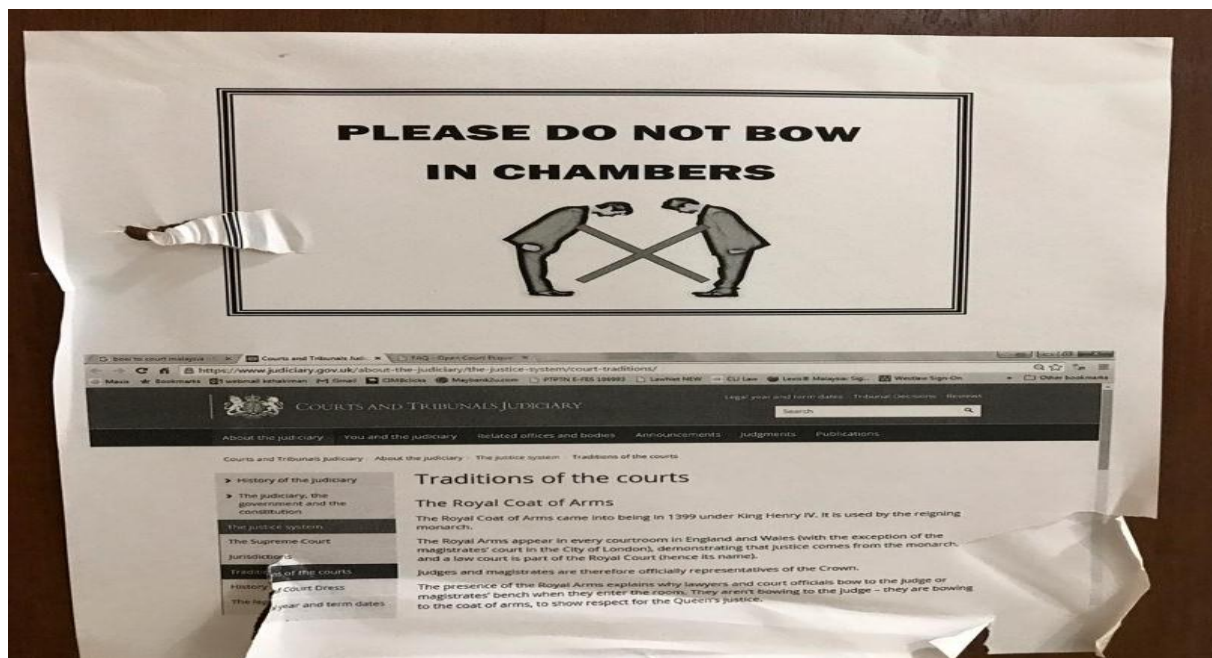

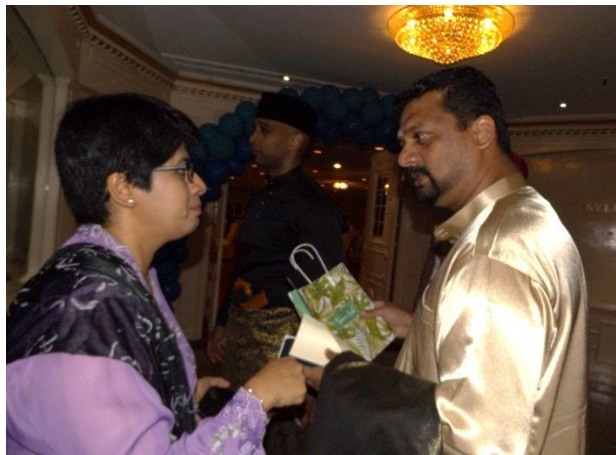

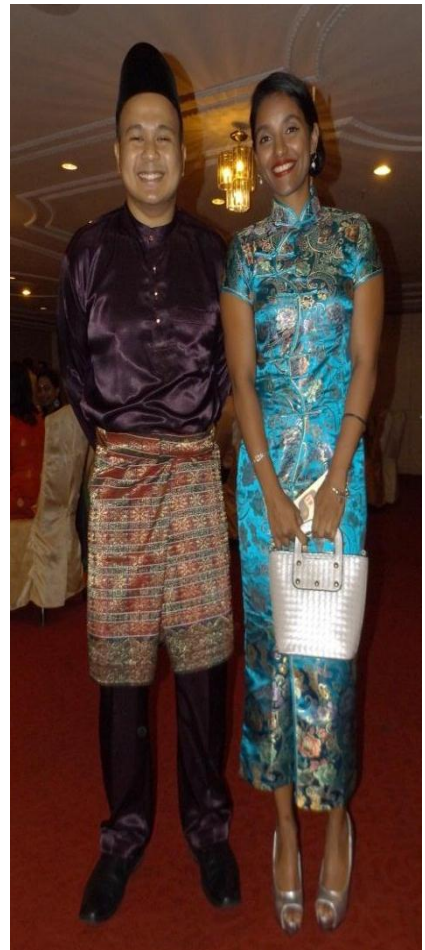
