Outline :

Committal Proceedings are commonly used to enforce orders obtained in family matters. As the proceedings are quasi criminal in nature, its procedural requirements are highly technical and need to be strictly complied with.

This talk will give an overview of committal proceedings and highlight common pitfalls to avoid. While the examples will be from the area of family law, the procedural session of the talk of general application in civil matters.
